## AIChE Projects Leadership Member Strike System

## Warnings

- 1. An AIChE Projects leadership member will receive a warning if
  - (a) They fail to give advance notice a **minimum of 24 hours** in advance to the Program Director if a deadline cannot be met.
  - (b) They consistently fail to keep general communication with the leadership team. Reasons include, but are not limited to:
    - i. Failing to respond to group messages if a response is prompted.
  - (c) They are consistently late to meetings
    - i. "Consistently" defined as 10 minutes late, 3 times (with no reasoning or bad reasoning, the criteria of which will be decided by the leadership members who attended the meeting on time)
  - (d) A required meeting minutes summary is not sent within 72 hours (see "leadership meetings" requirement in strikes\*\*\*)

## Strikes

- 1. An AIChE Projects leadership member will receive a strike if
  - (a) They receive three warnings. Note: <u>six</u> warnings leads to <u>two</u> strikes, and so on.
  - (b) They do not meet the event requirements for the respective quarter (as tracked by a spreadsheet managed by the Program Director). Event requirements include:
    - i. Fall & Spring Attend 4 required events
    - ii. Winter Attend 2 required events
    - iii. (1) Outreach Event

- (c) They do not give the Program Director 24 hours advance notice if they must miss a mandatory AIChE Projects Event with a valid excuse. Events and their associated "valid" excuses are listed below:
  - i. Emergency/Prior arrangements **ONLY** are valid excuses:
    - A. Leadership meetings. \*\*\*If a leadership meeting is missed, a summary of the meeting minutes must be sent to the Program Director within 72 hours of the end of the meeting, otherwise a warning will be issued (see warnings section)
    - B. Fall Welcome Night
    - C. Spring Showcase
  - ii. Emergency/class/other org or personal commitments:
    - A. AIChE Professional Development Workshop
    - B. AIChE Projects Technical Workshop
    - C. (1) of 2 AIChE GBMs
    - D. PM Alignment Meeting
    - E. AIChE Projects Interviews
- 2. Strike carry-over policy:
  - (a) Strikes will not carry over to the following academic year, but will carry throughout the quarters of that academic year

## Consequences of Strikes

- 1. Strike one: Talk with Program Director
- 2. Strike two: Talk with Program Director & Other Executive Leadership
- 3. Strike three: Termination of leadership position
