## AIChE Projects General Member Strike System

American Institute of Chemical Engineers (AIChE) Projects at University of California, San Diego

## Warnings

- 1. An AIChE Projects member will receive a warning if
  - (a) They fail to give advance notice a minimum of 24 hours in advance to their Project Manager(s) [PM(s)] if a deadline cannot be met. Exceptions based on emergency circumstances, e.g., a medical situation, will be made at the discretion of the PM(s).
  - (b) They consistently fail to keep general communication with their PM(s). Reasons include, but are not limited to:
    - i. Failing to respond to group messages if a response is prompted.

## Strikes

- 1. An AIChE Projects member will receive a strike if
  - (a) They receive three warnings. Note: <u>six</u> warnings leads to <u>two</u> strikes, and so on.
  - (b) When working on their project, at the discretion of their PM(s), they fail to uphold Environment, Health & Safety (EH&S) standards from themselves and/or those around them
  - (c) They do not meet the event requirements for the respective quarter. Exceptions based on emergency circumstances, e.g., a medical situation, will be made at the discretion of the PM(s). Event requirements include:
    - i. AIChE Professional Development Workshop
    - ii. AIChE Projects Technical Workshop
    - iii. AIChE Projects Fall Welcome Night
    - iv. AIChE Projects Spring Showcase

- v. 25% of total group meetings for the quarter. When 25% is not a whole number of meetings, round up, i.e., if there are nine group meetings per quarter, 25% is 2.25 meetings, which makes the requirement three meetings
  - A. Lateness Clause: If a member missed 25% or more of the meeting, that counts as an absence
  - B. Ultimately up to the discretion of the PMs.
- (d) They do not notify their PM(s) at least 24 hours in advance that they will not be able to attend an event. Exceptions for emergencies and unexpected events will be made at the discretion of the PM(s).
  - i. If a member has consistent and/or constant 48 hour advance notices, the PM may still grant a strike.
- 2. Strike carry-over policy:
  - (a) Strikes will not carry over to the following academic year, but will carry throughout the quarters of that academic year

## **Consequences of Strikes**

- 1. Strike one: Talk with Project Manager
- 2. Strike two: Talk with Project Manager and Program Manager
- 3. Strike three: Termination of participation in AIChE Projects
